PRAYER MEETINGS



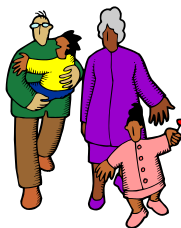
Please don't forget that the Prayer Meetings continue each week through the summer season.

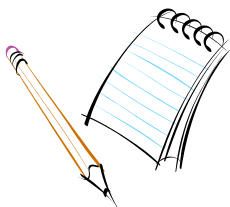
