Mary Vale Road Bridge Works

Recent inspections carried out by Network Rail have shown that Mary Vale Road Railway Bridge is weak in certain areas and does not meet current standards. The City Council will be carrying out works to provide protection to the weak areas of the bridge. Works are scheduled to begin 23 February 2009 and last for approximately 8 weeks.

After considering the options we propose to widen the footways over the bridge, protect them with safety kerbs and guardrails, and narrow the carriageway to allow only single file traffic controlled by traffic signals at either end of the bridge. The works will have an impact on vehicle and pedestrian traffic using the bridge.

To enable the works to be carried out safely:

- The carriageway will be closed between Franklin Way and Alexandra Road with access to frontages only.
- There will be a signed diversion route for local traffic.

Significant delays and disruption to traffic are not anticipated, however, there may be some minor disruptions within the area. Access to frontages, to Bournville Railway Station and for pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the works.

We apologise for any inconvenience that these works may cause, but we hope that you can appreciate the long-term safety benefits they will bring.
